Dear Parents/Carers,

What a busy start to the year, with so many changes! However, it is starting to feel a bit 'normal' again, but as we know, for many of our children the 'old normal' is a bit odd! It has been fantastic to have whole school worship again, be back in church, eating together and to have play times as a school!

As we approach Christmas (yes, I did say that word!) the pace of learning will continue to move forward and the teachers across the Federation have been working together to plan an exciting curriculum for next half term!

#### <u>Covid</u>

I'm afraid I can't let a newsletter pass by without a mention of covid. Although things seem to be returning back to normal slowly, we are also very aware that covid still remains with us. Thank you to everyone who has informed us when your child has tested positive, as this has helped us take any action needed, quickly - including increasing the frequency of staff testing. Please remember, should you or your child show any covid symptom, please seek a PCR test. For those who are double vaccinated, you are able to carry on as 'normal' should a member of your household test positive, but please remember, that if you test positive on a LFT test, you will need to have a PCR test. We are also urging everyone to work as hard as possible to get your child into school, as children under 18 are also permitted to carry on as normal, should a household member test positive.

#### <u>Volunteers</u>

We are hoping to begin to have volunteers back in school after half term. There are a series of safeguarding talks we are asking all potential regular volunteers to come to (dates of which can be found on our <u>website</u>). You can attend any talk at any one of our schools within the Federation. Even if you are considering volunteering towards the end of the year, my advice would be to come now for a talk, to hear important key messages. If you are only considering helping on trips, these meetings are not as essential, as the main key messages would always be discussed as part of the trip briefing.

#### **Tapestry**

Over the pandemic, we have used tapestry as a platform for sending home tasks and work for those not in school. If your child is isolating, but well enough to work, please do let the admin team know, as we will then ensure that home learning is set on tapestry, to try and keep your child's progress moving forward. We have been exploring how we plan to use tapestry moving forward and you will hopefully have been receiving updates on tapestry over the past few weeks. If not, it may be that there is an issue with your account – if so, please speak with the admin team and we will try and rectify this as soon as possible.

Please check your Parentmail account every day as this is how we send out all communication, including dates, forms for trips, parent consultation appointments and important notices.

#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### How can I make sure I'm alerted to a new notification ?

You can change your notification settings so that you receive a notification instantly, or to receive a summary of your notifications. You can vary these settings for account notifications, email, SMS and form notifications, event reminders and more. To do this, select your name on the toolbar and select 'Notification Settings'. This will open a list of all the variables that you will receive a notification for, select whether you would like to receive an instant email or a summary email for each, and click save. These changes will be made instantly.

#### How do I pay online ?

If you have a notification, it means your school have invited you to pay for something, or have notified you of a new payment item which is now available for you to buy or pre-order. Once in Payments, you will be able to view items "To Pay" or visit the "Shop".

#### Can I see my answers once I've completed a form, I can't remember if I ordered a lunch?

Yes, if you check in the archive section in the drop down menu, it should be stored there, or call us and we can check.

#### What do I do if I've missed the deadline to complete a form / pay for a trip.

Contact the office and we can complete it our end.

#### Can I pay by card ?

Yes you can, either online or pop into the office.

#### There are no times showing for parent consultation on the day that I want.

This means that the times have already been booked by another parent.

Can my partner or a grandparent be added to my child's Parentmail account.

Yes no problem. We just need the person's name, mobile number, email and relationship to the child.

#### My computer / phone is broken, can I still complete a form?

Yes. You can pop into the office or telephone and we can input your answers for you.

#### Is your child eligible for pupil premium funding?

Your child may be entitled to a sum of money, paid to the school, with the aim to boost their learning. This money is used by the school, to fund provisions with the aim of help-ing children in receipt of the pupil premium funding reach their best potential.

If you receive any of the following benefits you may be eligible:

Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)

Income support

Income-based jobseekers' allowance

Income-related employment and support allowance

Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

The guaranteed element of state pension credit

Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit

and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

There are many benefits to your child receiving pupil premium benefits, including <u>uniform</u> <u>vouchers</u> and <u>funding for school trips</u>. For a more comprehensive break down of how the federation spends this money, please see the pupil premium strategy, published on the website.
