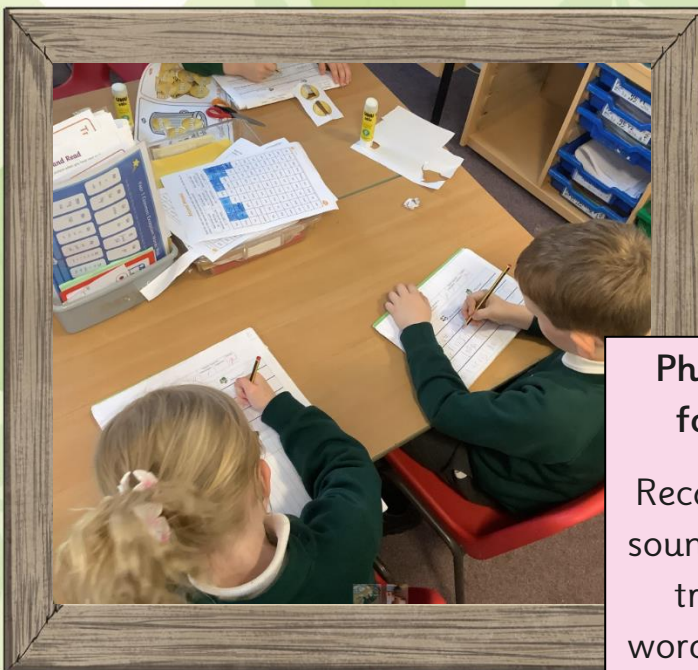


This week
