#### A Message from Mr Bowen

As always, our children have done us really proud! We have the highest number of children reaching age-related expectations and GDS at the end of Year Two that we have had for many years. We have been thrilled with this, following on from the success of our recent Ofsted and SIAMS inspections within the Federation.

#### **Staffing Changes**

I would like to welcome Mr Warren, who will be taking the baton from Mr Noble at Netley Marsh and acting as the Federation's Year Two lead. Mr Warren is currently employed in Salisbury and will be starting after October half term.

In the interim, Mrs Maclaurin (our current Year 1 lead, working alongside Mrs Maddams – an experienced school senior leader) will be teaching in Butterfly Class for the first half term. Mrs Maclaurin, as Year One lead, is already familiar with the work of the children within this class, and both teachers have a history of excellent practice and high outcomes.

In Year R at Copythorne, I would also like to welcome Miss Campone, who some of you will already know, having undertaken previous training at Copythorne. Miss Campone will be taking over from Mr Cooper, who is off on the adventure of a lifetime around the world.

It is a fond farewell to Mrs Thomas, who is retiring after a long and successful career. She will be greatly missed. Mrs Maclaurin (our current Year One lead) will be stepping up for the year as interim SENCO for the Federation, working across the schools for three days a week and eventually teaching alongside our newest teacher, Mrs Langton, in Hedgehog Class at Copythorne. Mrs Langton will be teaching full time until October half term, when Mrs Maclaurin will return to Copythorne and teach alongside Mrs Langton.

Mrs Steen, who has also been working in Butterfly Class at Netley Marsh, will be moving schools to support learning at Copythorne. We know she will continue to be great in her new school!

Mrs Pickering will also be leaving the Federation. Mrs Pickering has worked across all three of our schools, supporting teaching and learning, and I know she will be very much missed.

We have also employed a new site manager! We are thrilled to welcome Mr Dunn to the team!

And – as you will know – I would also like to bid a final farewell, as I move to my new Federation of Burley Primary School and Sopley Primary School. Mrs Flynn will be stepping into the role of interim headteacher, while the governors continue to work with the local authority to ensure that the Federation moves forward in the best direction. ### Next Year

As always, we have spent a considerable amount of time this year reflecting on our practice-celebrating what is going well and identifying areas for growth. Looking ahead, we are excited to be embarking on an ambitious new project next year. Our focus will be on supporting children to better understand their own brains, while also developing a deeper awareness of the many reasons people behave in the ways they do. This work will shape not only our approach to teaching but also inform the future direction of our behaviour policy.

This initiative is already underway at Hounsdown and Testwood, and next year Bartley and The Oaks will be working closely together to develop a shared, collaborative approach that enhances both pupil behaviour and adult understanding of behaviour.

We've already begun working with Kit Messenger to build expertise within our school systems, and we're looking forward to continuing this journey. As part of this, we will be launching whole-school training during our October INSET day, with further updates to follow after this next stage of development.

In the meantime, for those of you who enjoy some light educational reading, I recommend Curious Not Furious by Alison Rendle and Kit Messenger, which is helping to guide and influence our thinking and practice.

#### Summer School

Please don't panic at the thought of no school over the summer! We know that for many of our children, the summer break provides a great opportunity to rest and reconnect with friends and family. For others, it can leave a yearning for study.
