Literacy

This week, we have been exploring different habitats from the story 'Dear Earth.' Year 2 have been learning to use commas in lists and Year 1 have been practising capital letters and full stops in their sentence writing.

Maths

Year 1 have been partitioning teen numbers in to 'ten and some more' (i.e. $14 = 10$ and 4 more) whilst Year 2 have learnt a new 'smile' technique

for adding two 2-digit numbers

$$\text{ie. } 32 + 24 = 56$$

$$30 + 20 = 50$$

$$2 + 4 = 6$$
