Some spellings from Year 2

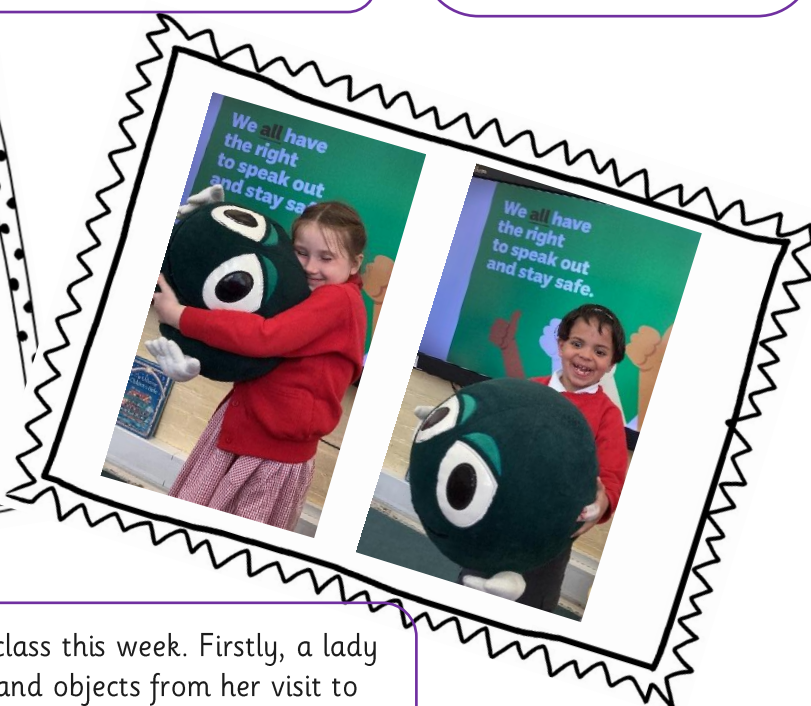
Suffixes- swap, double or drop?
