As pupils progress, they will be able to think critically and develop a more rigorous understanding of art and design and know how art and design both reflects and shapes our history, and contributes to the culture, creativity and wealth of our nation.

- Explore their ideas and record their experiences.
- Become appropriately proficient in drawing, painting, sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques.
- Evaluate and analyse creative works using a rich language of art, craft and design.
- Know about accomplished artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.

- Produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences
- Become proficient in drawing painting and sculpture and other art, craft and design techniques
- Evaluate and analyse creative works using the language of art, craft and design
- Know about great artists, craft makers and designers, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms.
