# Grow For It!

**Hook:** A letter arrives for us from the Allotment Association with a voucher for £100. They must decide how to spend it on Copythorne's garden. We need to consider what to plant, what will grow best and how to be successful in growing plants and vegetables!

**Science:** we will identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants and trees. Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants and trees. We will observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will experiment how plants need water, light and a sustainable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

**Geography:** we will set up a weather station in our school grounds. We will observe and record daily weather patterns and data. We will consider seasonal changes and weather patterns.

**Outcome:** As a class, we will enjoy a garden party in our space and reflect on and enjoy all that we have achieved!

**English:** we will write a report about our scientific observations and experiments. We will listen to and enjoy a range of poetry and stories considering the language used. We will generate descriptive language to help us write more imaginatively and use this to write descriptive passages describing a garden.

**Spirituality:** we will enjoy peace and stillness and appreciate personal space. We will think deeply about the world around us and find things that amaze and inspire us.

**Stewardship:** we will reflect on our role and responsibility in ensuring we take care of and respect our local environment.
