School reminders

Sickness—it is that time again when sickness bugs are common, please can we remind you that you are required to keep your child home from school for 48 hours following the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea.

The local authority have a list on their website of common childhood illnesses and conditions from conjunctivitis to head lice, as well as symptoms such as a high temperature and a sore throat and what these might mean. There is advice about what to do and when a child should return to education after being treated.
