Throughout May/June	Forms will be sent out via Parentmail for parents to complete and return	To ensure we have all the required information about your child.
During the summer term	Our website will be updated with useful information and a video introducing your child to their new class teachers.	To get to know your child's teaching staff. Parents can learn more about aspects of school life.

Wednesday 12 th July 2023 2pm	Teddy Bears Picnic	A chance for families to connect with the class teacher.
4 th - 8 th September 2023	Home visits this week	Getting to know you and your child. We will contact you in advance to let you know your home visit appointment time and date.
11 th – 15 th September	Part time attendance, for children whose birthdays fall in the following dates - 1st Sept to 31st Jan Attend Tues, Thurs, Fri 1st Feb to 31st Aug Attend Mon, Wed, Fri	Getting used to school routines.
18 th September	All children to attend full time	Hooray we are at school!
